

MEDICATION / HEALTH CARE PLANS POLICY

1.0 Purpose:

- 1.1 To promote the inclusion of all children regardless of medical conditions and help all children to achieve and to make progress, whatever their medical needs
- 1.2 To safeguard children's health and safety by ensuring that prescribed medicines are handled responsibly and safely
- 1.3To ensure correct procedure is followed when administrating medication

2.0 General

- 2.1 Parents should keep their children at home if there is a risk of infecting other children or staff.
- 2.2 Parents should inform the Nursery of the nature of infection so other parents can be informed.
- 2.3 Parents should complete a healthcare plan upon admission, if required, so all members of staff are aware of the child's medical needs.
- 2.4 Children should not come to Nursery until at least 48hours have passed following diarrhoea or vomiting.
- 2.5 Children of staff who are unwell shall not be brought into Nursery.

3.0 Responsibility:

Manager-To ensure this procedure is followed.

4.0 Procedures

- 4.1 Whenever possible the parents shall administer all medication.
- 4.2 Parents/guardians are responsible for restocking of medicines
- 4.3 If medication time falls within Nursery time then:
 - a) The medicine shall be clearly labelled, valid and the correct name must be on the bottle.
 - b) Permission, dosage and timings shall be written down for the staff on the appropriate documents and signed by the parent. Verbal instructions shall not be accepted.
 - c) Only medication prescribed by a child's own doctor shall be administered by the staff after appropriate authorisation from parents.
 - d) Parent(s)/guardian will be requested to complete the 'consent form' to seek medical treatment or advice as well as a health care plan for children with long term medical conditions.
 - e) Suitable storage will be provided for the safe keeping of medication whilst on Nursery premises.
 - f) Written records will be kept of medicine administrated to children.
 - a) Parents are informed once medicine is administrated.
 - h) Provide training to staff if any administrating requires technical/medical knowledge
 - i) Only allows the administrating of pain and fever relief where there is a health reason to do so which only Manager can authorize
 - j) Does not allow the administering of any medicine which contains aspirin unless it has been prescribed by a doctor



- k) Stores all medicines strictly in accordance with product instructions and in the original container in which it is dispensed together with the prescriber's instructions for administration.
- 4.4 All health care plans will be reviewed annually. Members of staff should be informed of any changes or updates
